Relationship




Students will develop and demonstrate Christ's character.

The mission of the Twelve (Luke 9:1-6)

- Cast out demons (v.1)
- Heal diseases (v. 1)
- Proclaim the good news (v.6)

The mission of the Seventy-Two (Luke 10:1-17)

- Heal the sick (v. 9)
- Proclaim the Kingdom (v.9)
- Subdue demons (v.17)

The instructions to the Twelve (Luke 9:1-6)

- No walking stick, no bag no bread, no money, no extra shirt (v.3)
- Stay in homes (v.4)
- Shake the dust off if they reject you (v.5)

The instructions to the Seventy-Two (Luke 10:1-17)

- No purse, traveling bag, or sandals (v. 4)
- Stay in homes (v.7)
- Subdue demons (v.17)
- Shake the dust off your feet if they reject you (v. 10)

The Example Jesus Set

At that time Jesus healed many people of diseases, plagues, and evil spirits, and He granted sight to many blind people. He replied to them, "Go and report to John the things you have seen and heard: The blind receive their sight, the lame walk, those with skin diseases are healed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news preached to them.
